Department of Biotechnology, FET and Department of Nutrition and Dietetics, FAS, MRIIRS jointly organized a student workshop on “**FERMENTED FOODS**” under the guidance of Dr. Sarita Sachdeva, Dean Research and FAS, Dr. Nidhi Didwania, Associate Professor, Department of Biotechnology and Mrs. Lakhvinder Kaur, Assistant Professor, Department of Nutrition on 16th August 2018. The resource person for the event was Mr. Achintya Anand, a young entrepreneur and Founder of ‘KRISHI CRESS’, which is a Delhi-based farming initiative offering quality farm-fresh vegetables, herbs and other culinary requirements for chefs, discerning restaurants and home cooks.

The workshop started with a formal Introduction and Welcome and then Mr. Achintya Anand introduced students to his enterprise ‘KRISHI CRESS’. He is an international chef turned micro greens farmer and grows 15 varieties of micro greens and supplies across New Delhi and Gurgaon. Along with microgreens they are also involved in preparation of fermented foods like Sauerkraut, Kimchi and Kombucha. He emphasized on the **importance of fermented foods** by explaining their health promoting benefits, **therapeutic potential** and **improved nutrient content**. Students showed great interest and enthusiasm in his talk and were highly motivated and keen to learn and apply idea of microgreens and fermentation. Their curiosity reflected in the great volume of questions posed by them. Students' queries and doubts were all well addressed.

Today's students are tomorrow's potential entrepreneurs. However, there is little understanding of the factors that affect students' motivation of becoming entrepreneurs and the relationship between entrepreneurship education and students' entrepreneurial attitudes towards entrepreneurship. This workshop seeks to contribute toward redressing this gap and motivate students towards entrepreneurship.

REPORT OF WORKSHOP ON "GEOTECHNICAL INVESTIGATIONS".

A workshop on "Geotechnical Investigations". was organized by the Department Civil Engineering on 27.02.2019 specializing in the field of Soil Mechanics. 48 students from the Civil Engineering Department attended the workshop.

Soil Investigation or Geotechnical Investigation is a procedure that determines the stratigraphy (study of rocks) and relevant physical properties of the soil underlying the site. This is done to ensure that this substructure, which is eventually going to hold up homes, is safe and enduring. For any civil engineering project, however big or small, it is of primary importance that a proper field survey and a very precise geotechnical investigation be conducted. **Geotechnical investigation is** an integral part of the **construction process** which is done to obtain information about the physical characteristics of soil/rock around a site. It is a below-ground investigation wherein the **soil strata is sampled** and tested to establish its characteristics, which will influence the construction project.

These investigations form the basis for **planning, designing, and constructing the structures.** The serviceability and performance of the structure depend on the accuracy and adequacy of these investigations. How accurate the information in the **geotechnical report** is strongly influences the **design, construction, project cost, and safety.**

Report on One day visit to Signature Bridge, Delhi

Department of Civil Engineering, Faculty of Engineering and Technology, Manav Rachna International Institute of Research and Studies (MRIIRS), Faridabad organized a one day visit to **Signature Bridge at Wazirabad, Delhi on 30th October 2018**. A group of 48 students along with Ms.Sonal Bhugra, Mr.Aamir Mazhar, Mr.Karan Prabhakar & Ms.Shiuli Sikder Paul proceeded for the visit.

An ambitious project of the Delhi Tourism and Transport Development Corporation (DTTDC), the cable stayed Bridge will link National Highway Number 1 near existing T-point at Wazirabad on Western bank and marginal Bund Road at Khajuri Khas on Eastern Bank of Yamuna river **thus connecting North Delhi with East Delhi**.

On the site students were attended by **Mr Gaurav Khanna** who briefed the students about the structural specifications of the bridge. The **Signature Bridge at Wazirabad** is India's first asymmetrical cable-stayed bridge with a main span of **251 meters and total length of 675 meters**. The pylon of the Signature bridge is the tallest structure in Delhi and is **double the height of Qutub Minar** with its **154-metre high** viewing box, which acts as selfie points for visitors. It shortens the travel time between north and northeast Delhi.

The bridge composite deck carries 8 lanes (4 in each direction). It is about 35 m wide and is supported by lateral cable spaced at 13.5 meters intervals. The height of the Steel tower (pylon) is 154m.

Two carriageways, typically 14.00 meter wide and separated by a concrete crash barrier as well as two lateral emergency pathways, form the deck of the bridge that totals 35.2 meters in width. Each of the carriageways accommodates four traffic lanes. The deck is formed of outer I-shaped longitudinal main girders and I-shaped cross girders at 4.5 meter intervals. A third central main girder is placed to distribute heavy truck loads onto several cross girders. All structural steel is grade S:355 (or the Indian equivalent). Shop welding and site splices with high strength friction grip bolts are used. The pre-cast deck slabs of concrete grade M50 span 4.5 meters. Their standard thickness of 25 cm increases to 70 cm at the main tower and in the area of the backstay anchorage.

Students had a great learning experience, wherein they were able to relate their theoretical knowledge with the practical execution. They were also briefed about various challenges of DTTDC during the course of its construction.





Outcomes:



Awareness of Futuristic Technologies Program on " Intelligent Machining & CNC Systems"


The Department of Mechanical Engineering has organised an "Intelligent Machining & CNC Systems" keeping in view the development of the futuristic perspective of machining and development of advanced cutting tool material. This awareness program was organised for students of Mechanical, Automobile and Aeronautical Engineering because of prospective material and high strength alloys development for aerospace and automotive components machining from 16th to 18th August 2018 and around 28 students participated in the program

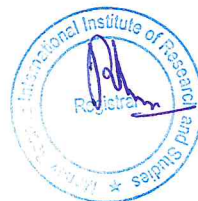

A Report on the visit to “Public Health Foundation of India (PHFI)” on Feb 8, 2019

Students of M.Sc Nutrition and Dietetics with faculty members, Ms.Vandana Garg and Ms. Divya Puri visited the most renowned **PHFI Research Lab, Gurugram on 8th February 2019.**

PHFI was created as a public-private initiative and launched in 2006 with the aim of enhancing the capacity of public health professionals in the country. PHFI has established five Indian Institutes of Public Health (IIPHs) in Bhubaneswar, Delhi, Gandhinagar, Hyderabad and Shillong.

During the visit, students got an overview of bio-repository unit (storage of 55,000 samples at -80°C), the Biochemistry and Genetic lab. Students were briefed about all the lab amenities, biochemical and genetic tests and procedures undertaken as a part of research studies. Students were also acquainted about the procedures of sample collection (blood, urine, saliva, etc) processing and sample analysis for various parameters (i.e. lipid profile, inflammatory markers and biomarkers, etc).

The visit proved to be an insight about the interdisciplinary approach of public health aspects for health promotion. It was a great learning experience to relate theoretical knowledge of various epidemiological study designs with the ongoing research projects at PHFI. Department is thankful to **Dr. Prabhakaran, Vice President, PHFI** without his support the visit would not have been possible. Department is also thankful to Dr. Ruby Gupta (Senior Research Biochemist) and Dr. Aastha Aggarwal (Senior Research Scientist) and the whole team at PHFI Lab. We are also grateful to Registrar and Dean **FAS (MRIIRS)** and the transport department for extending all the support in facilitating this.
