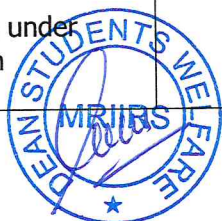

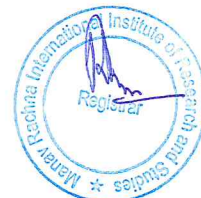

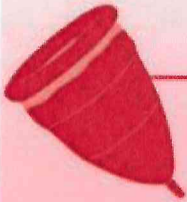

THREE WEEKS WORKSHOP on WOMEN MENSTRUAL HYGIENE Program in MOHNA VILLAGE

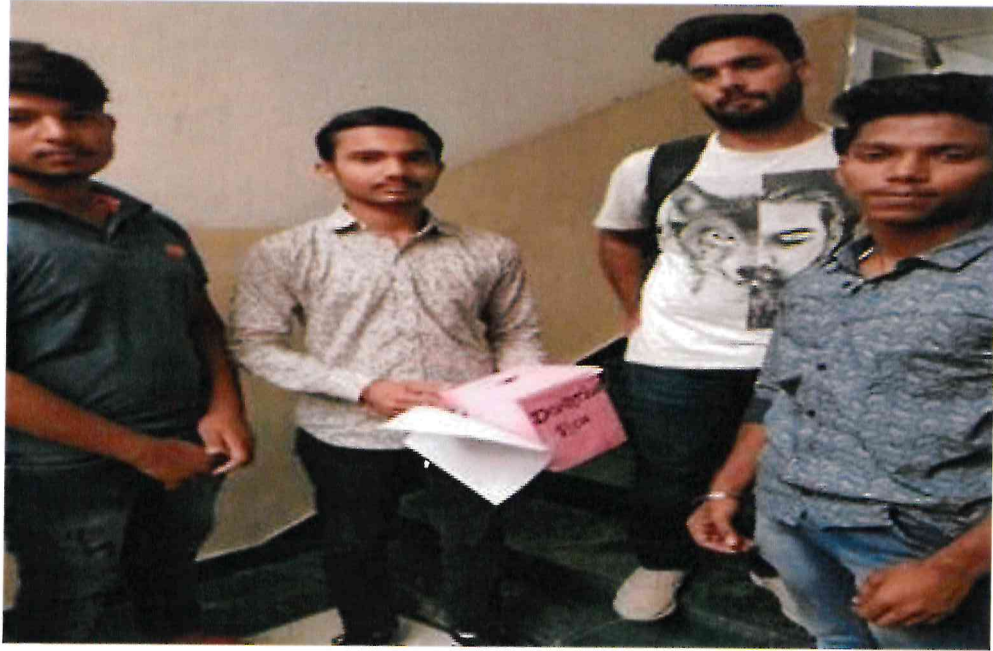
Under the Manav Rachna Life Skill Program, a workshop from 5.10.18 to 26.10.18 was organized. Students from various faculties like, FET, FCBS, FCA, FAS along with four faculty members went to Mohna Village, an adopted village under Institutional Social Responsibilities. Fund collection Program was organized to collect donations and a donation of approximately 4600/- was collected by the students and faculty members of MRIIRS.

The registered students for the activity were given a few sessions by the faculty members before organizing the event in the village community regarding Women Menstrual Hygiene so that they are well versed with the information of related taboos which will be further deliberated to all females in the community by them.

The trained students further organized awareness sessions for females in the community to sensitize them about Menstrual Hygiene. The objective was to promote awareness among females and their families and also to share the information about hygienically disposal of used clothes and pads and distribution of free Sanitary napkins which inturn helped in environment protection.

A question answer session was also conducted to provide an opportunity to the girls for taking their doubts, queries, misunderstandings to get cleared by the students of MRIIRS. The discussion also focused upon menstrual health and hygiene which were not exclusive to the topic. With the dedication of all the faculty members and students and the coordination of village students and their teachers the event was conducted smoothly.

Report on ONE MONTH ENVIRONMENT PROTECTION CAMPAIGN

Under Manav Rachna Life Skill Program, an Anti-Cracker awareness Campaign was organized by University students and Faculty Members of MRIIRS to control air pollution. The faculty members played an important role in the Anti – Fire Campaign and the registered students make every member of MRIIRS aware about the hazardous effects of bursting crackers on Diwali. Air Pollution affects the overall health of an individual. The adverse effect of bursting crackers seems unending. Crackers often contain elements like copper, cadmium, sulphur to produce vibrant colors once ignited. The harmful gases produced from the bursting of crackers, such as Nitrous Oxide, remain in the air for a long time if the city doesn't get enough rain or strong winds. Inhaling the fumes emitted by firecrackers increase the chances of asthma attack among patients. Heart patients and patients of chronic bronchitis and low immune system are at high risk too. The event disseminated information about the harmful effects of bursting fire crackers & also created awareness about the poor working conditions.
