MRIIRS is having in house facility of clinical Out patient departments of physiotherapy, Nutrition and Dietetics, Dental and Psychology.

Physiotherapy OPD: The specialized OPDs in the form of Cerebral Palsy Clinic, Stroke Clinic, Geriatric Clinic, Sports Injury Clinic, and Diet and Nutrition Clinic is in campus to facilitate the inpatient and outpatient. Other specialized OPDs is run at the department from time to time in the form of clinical weeks. All clinics are supported by well-equipped equipment. Faculty of Applied Sciences has collaboration with Gerlev PE & Sports Academy, Denmark; Lahti University of Applied Sciences, Finland; Laurea University of Applied Sciences, and many more.

Diet and Nutrition clinic: The objective of Diet and Nutrition clinic was to provide nutrition support with regard to nutritional assessment, nutritional awareness, providing guidelines to prevent communicable and non-communicable disease and providing treatment of various metabolic disorder. Many patients of different ailments were catered such as hypothyroidism, diabetes, kidney disorder, liver disorder, hyperlipidaemia, hypertension, obesity, weight gain and many more. Health camps are organized at regular intervals to different areas of Delhi, NCR so as to reach out



to those people who are unable to visit in OPD. In camps, we provide free consultation and assessments to people who are in need. We explain them about their conditions and guide them dos and don'ts with nutrition perspective.

Dental OPD: Dental Department has a unique state-of-the-art facility in itself, housing a perfect combination of high-end technology. A team of highly skilled and experienced Doctors meet all dental needs in specialized area of orthodontics and Dentofacial orthopaedics, periodontology, prosthodontics, oral pathology & microbiology, conservative dentistry and endodontics, paediatric and preventive dentistry, oral medicine and radiology, oral & maxillofacial surgery, public health dentistry. From July 2022 till August 2023, the number of patients treated in **Dental OPD were nearly 117837.**

Psychology OPD: मनोvriti Counselling and Wellness Centre by the Department of Applied Psychology is a hub that provides guidance and counselling support to MREI family. The centre works keeping in mind the realities of life and the challenges faced by students, faculty and staff. The centre is functional at BG-15, B-Block, Manav Rachna International Institute of Research and Studies (MRIIRS). The centre provides various services to its clients to support and enhance their psychological well-being, some of the services are Individual and group Counselling, Psychological Testing, Career exploration and counselling, Hypnotherapy, Consultation services for family members and faculty with regard to particular students, within the boundary of confidentiality, Training for competent students and para-professionals under proper supervision.

collaborations among the numerous sectors that are jointly accountable for constructing a more just and equitable society. **Dental sciences** collaborated with Balaji Dental and Craniofacial Hospital Chennai for academic and clinical training of the students.

More than twenty of the greatest **hospitals** in the area have joined together to provide MRIIRS's for providing the clinical tie-ups and internships to the students. Students, faculty, schoolchildren, villagers, societies, and the like are regularly invited to participate in blood donation, stem cell donation, pulse polio, health awareness, cancer awareness, psychological counselling, tobacco and drug awareness, dental hygiene, menstrual hygiene, and other similar camps.
