

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1. INTRODUCTION

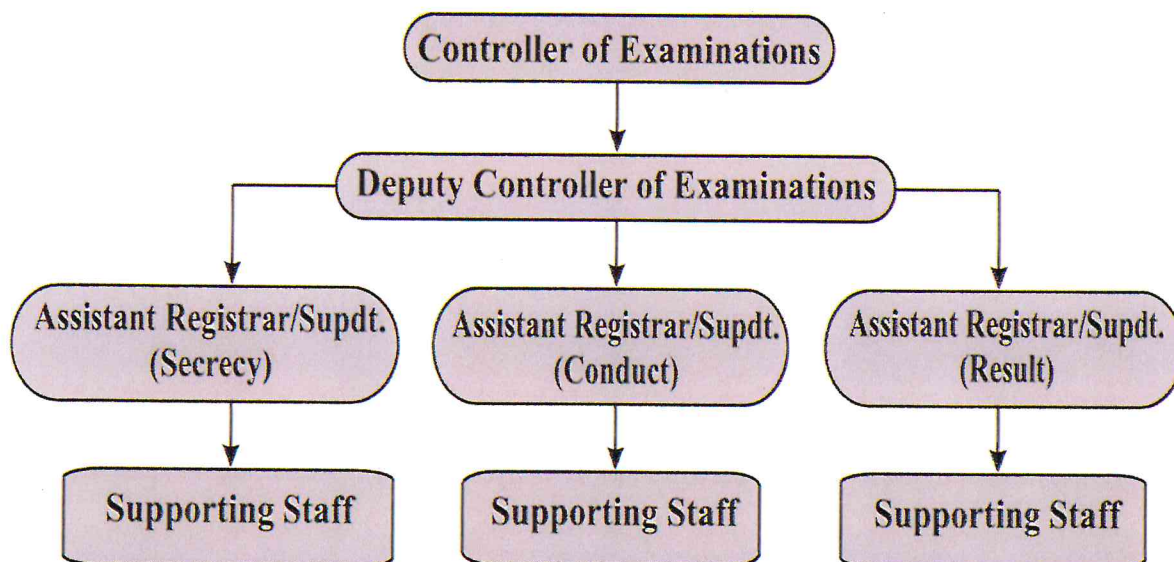
Examination function in the education system of a Higher Education Institute holds a pivotal position. It's the much avowed objective of any HEI to ensure that the students during the tenure of their education acquire the Graduate Attributes (GAs), Programme Educational Objectives (PEOs), Programme outcomes (POs), Programme Specific outcomes (PSOs) and Course outcomes (COs) of different courses. These outcomes have to be suitably aligned and measured in an Outcome Based Education. Evaluation through Examinations- both Formative and Summative provides the necessary prime mover to accomplish this all- important task. Therefore a sound, robust, transparent and technology-enabled examination system with high reliability and fidelity has to be a *sine quo non* in an HEI for it to prosper and inspire confidence in its stakeholders.

Adhering to the above, MRIIRS have in place a time-tested examination system in place which has incorporated the aforesaid basic tenets. We continuously continue to hold consultative meetings for ushering in reforms to bring about accretion to efficacy and integrity of our examination system. Technology and various psychometric techniques are leveraged to enhance the quality level of the system.

2. ORGANIZATION STRUCTURE OF THE EXAMINATION BRANCH

The operations of the Examination Branch are granularized into three broad areas: Conduct, Result and Award Management. Each one of these verticals is looked after by a dedicated Deputy Superintendent / Superintendent. All functions germane to question paper settings are included in the Conduct vertical. Result and Award Management are the other two verticals. These functionaries report to Dy. COE and COE. PVC of the University guides and oversees the Branch with COE at the helm of affairs. As of now, all the functionaries are very well experienced with an average tenure of over 6 years at this University.

4. CONDUCT OF END SEMESTER EXAMS (DEC, 2019 AND MAY 2020)

- During the 2019-2020 academic year; 82 examinations for Undergraduate, Postgraduate & Ph.D. programs were conducted.
- The examinations of Mid Term Examinations (MTE) and End-Term Examinations (ETE) have been conducted as per Academic Calendar, notified by the Dean-Academics.
- End Semester Exams of Dec 2019 were conducted from 11.12.2019 to 17.01.2020 and Exams of May 2020 were conducted from 11.05.2020 to 30.05.2020 as per respective date sheets.
- The date sheet for each programme had been notified well in advance and circulated to all Dean(s)/Websites/Notice Boards of the University.
- **Confidential work:** The panel of question paper setters duly approved by BOS had been invited from the respective departments, selection of the paper setters was done, 1476 numbers of offer letters were sent. After receipt of question papers, the Moderators did moderation of the question papers. The selected question papers were printed & packed in the designated sealed cover envelopes. The sealed envelopes were dispatched at the examination centers half hour before on each day of examination.
- **Conduct Committee:** The examination Supdt./Dy. Supdt. are appointed through office order for the conduct the examinations at designated examination center, vide notification issued on 26.11.2019 (Dec. 2019).
- **Flying Squad:** To prevent the unfair Means practices during the examination, flying squad was appointed to ensure fair and smooth conduct of examination.
- **Evaluation Committee:** The evaluation Supdt./Dy. Supdt. were also been appointed again through office order to supervise the process of evaluation at a designated evaluation center, vide notification issued on 26.11.2019.
- **Open house:** The open house sessions had been conducted at the department level to show the evaluated answer sheets to the concerned students to establish the fair and transparent evaluation. The anomalies, if any, were corrected.



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- **Result Preparation:**
 - i) Subsequent to the receipt of sessional and end semester marks from the faculty, final result is prepared by deploying an in-house developed software.
 - ii) The result preparation comprises two level rationalization/moderation. In the first constituent step, for any one programme, global overage of marks of all courses involved was computed for theory papers only. Marks of all courses were rationalized with respect to this global overage. This ensures that any deviation because of varying degrees of difficulty of question paper, if any, were smoothened. In the second level of moderation, frequency distribution of marks and grades was first worked out, then using the principle of relative grading, threshold levels of different grades were suitably modified, if needed. This was executed by a committee comprising respective Deans, COE and HODs.
 - iii) After this the data was transmitted to another constituent automated unit for preparation of Grade Cards, transcript and degrees with security features and photographs affixed.
- **Result Declaration:** The results for all the programmes have been declared as per procedure within stipulated time, vide exam branch notification dated on 29.01.2020 (Dec. 2019) and 06.06.2020. (May 2020)
- **Annual average of time taken to declare the results:** 11.96 days.

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6. CONVOCATION:

Convocation was held on 21.01.2021 in which 1441 degrees of UG&PG program and 32 degrees of Ph.D programme alongwith transcript were awarded to the eligible students. A total of 53 Medals and Awards were also given to the meritorious students and outstanding achievers of the University.

7. STATUS OF ISO 9001:2015

The department has initiated the process to obtain ISO 9000 during the AY 2018-19.

ISO 9001:2015 certification is provided by ISO Certification Bodies (CBs) which are accredited by NABCB (National Accreditation Board for Certification Bodies, a constituent of Quality Council of India) or accreditation Boards of other member Countries.

- During August 2019, quotations were invited to finalize the ISO 9001:2015 Certification Body. It was decided to contact only those ISO Certification Bodies which are accredited by NABCB.
- During September 2019, working on the first draft of QMS of Examination was started.
- During November 2019, Sealed Quotations were submitted to committee constituting PVC, Registrar and Dean FET.
- During February 2020, BSCIC Certification as Certification body was finalized.
- Quality Management System Manual was prepared and submitted in June 2020.

Initial inspection has been done and the necessary verification process shall be undertaken by an outside accrediting agency soon.

8. PERSPECTIVE PLANNING FOR NEXT ACADEMIC YEAR

Various psychometric developments in conjunction with the digital technology offer compelling reasons to undertake examination reforms in a continuous manner to enhance its efficacy.

MRIIRS has a long-term plan to:

- 2.1 Increase capacity so as to cope up with ever-increasing number of new courses and programmes.
- 2.2 Make the entire examination system 100% automated without even a modicum of manual intervention.
- 2.3 To work towards a quality level wherein instances of grievances and resorting to unfair means by the examinees shall be minimalistic.
- 2.4 To work up to acquire technology for online evaluation of physical examinations.
- 2.5 To immerse conduct of online examinations under a highly proctored environment and carry out AI- assisted evaluation to the extent possible.

10. IMPROVEMENT/REFORMS (MODERATION):

10.1 ANNUAL PLAN FOR AY 2019-20:

The following reforms have been planned this year:

4.1 Digitalization of Question paper management

The question paper management was done paperless. Only final question papers to be administered to the students to be printed.



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4.2 Initiation to ISO-9000:2015 certification

The department has initiated the process to obtain ISO 9001:2015 certification. Initial inspection is done.

4.3 Conduct of Online Examination: To face any eventuality and also to innovate, it is being planned to develop a system which would include deployment of a suitable platform to assign the question paper, proctoring, uploading of answer sheets.

10.2 ICT INTEGRATION AND REFORMS:

- i) Digitalization of Question paper management:
The question paper management was done paperless.
- ii) Initiation to ISO-9000: The department has initiated the process to obtain ISO 9000 Initial inspection has been done and the necessary verification process shall be undertaken by an outside accrediting agency soon.
- iii) Supplementary Exam Forms were filled by the students in online mode through i-cloud EMS.
- iv) Due to present pandemic situation the End Semester and sessionals were conducted online. The exams were conducted on MS TEAMS and GOOGLE MEET platforms. The exams were proctored and answer sheets were uploaded online. The instructions issued to students and faculty were quite elaborate and lucid. Online evaluation was carried out and the award lists were communicated to the exam branch and the results were prepared and declared on time.
- v) Time taken to declare the result was reduced from previous academic year average of 12.42 days to 11.96 days this academic year.
- vi) Grievance percentage was reduced from 0.40% of previous academic year to 0.27% this academic year.
- vii) Configuration of Open Elective Courses was made fully functional during even sem of AY 2019-20.
- viii) Analysis of COs, POs and PSOs was done through EMS.
